- Report Spam on Facebook: Navigate to the offending post or comment, click the three dots at the top right, choose "Report," and select "Spam or misleading content."
- Block Troublesome Users: To block someone, visit their profile, click the three dots at the top right, and select "Block." This stops them from seeing or commenting on your posts.

 - Be Cautious with Links: Avoid clicking links in spam comments to prevent visiting malicious websites.
 - Ignore Spam Comments: Do not respond to spam, as this can encourage spammers.
